

## Tularcitos Elementary School Virtual Talent Show Guidelines

Tularcitos students in grades 3,4, and 5 are encouraged to participate in the upcoming Virtual Talent Show. The Talent Show is an opportunity for students to showcase one of their special skills or talents in front of their fellow students and school community.

A list of potential talent show acts, individual or group, is as follows, but you can do others. Time limit is **2 minutes per act**. Group acts are allowed, but students are expected to be masked and families are encouraged to consider the current COVID situation before allowing students to gather to do this performance.

- Singers/vocalists
- Comedy skits
- Dance
- Poetry Reading
- Musicians
- Skits
- Magician
- Floor gymnastics

### Dates and Deadlines:

- Friday, 1/8/21: Online Talent Show Participation Agreement Form must be submitted ([Link to Form](#))
- Friday, 1/15/21: Students hear back if act is approved or needs adjusting
- Friday, 2/5/21: A video of the act needs to be submitted (that will be sent out in January to everyone)
- Friday, 2/26 at 6:30 pm: Live airing of the Talent Show

### Talent Show Requirements:

- Complete the online Talent Show Participatoin Agreement Form by Friday, 1/8/21 (link above)
- Any act with a song must submit a copy of the lyrics with the Agreement Form to ensure the content and words are school appropriate. If the music has no lyrics, the name of the song is needed.
- Committee will approve all acts that audition and fall within the criteria by Friday 1/15/21.
- Performers must work within the 2 minute time allotment.
- Performances (and music) must be in good taste and exemplify the Tularcitos pillars of character.
- Musical lyrics and acts cannot have any profanity or inappropriate content.
- Students can participate in a maximum of two performances – one individual and one group act.
- Participants in group acts must wear a mask and parents are encouraged to consider the current COVID situation before allowing their children to participate in group acts.
- Students will submit a video of their act by Friday, 2/5/21, to a form that will come out in January.
