- Provide a positive home atmosphere and attitude toward learning and encourage your child to do his/her best.
- Be knowledgeable about and participate in the opportunities for parent involvement.
- Establish a time and place where homework can be completed and reviewed. Have your child explain their homework to you so you can gauge their understanding.
- Talk with your child about their learning experiences at school.
- Read aloud to your child and listen to your child read or retell stories and poems to you.
- Show your child the importance of reading and writing in daily life.
- Monitor your child's television viewing and watch programs with your child whenever possible. Limit computer game time and encourage exercise through play.
