6th Grade Classes

All 6th graders take:

6th Grade Elective Course Descriptions:

Cycle: Students rotate through 6 weeks each of the following courses: **French, Art, Chinese, Industrial Arts, Spanish and Computers.** These courses are designed to be an introduction into a wide variety of electives, which students may choose to further study in their 7th / 8th grade year.

Chorus: (1 year course) Students learn to read and perform music through a study of vocal and choral music. Performances will be given during each trimester and students are required to attend and participate.

Beginning Instruments: (1 year course) Band Class or Strings Class is for students wishing to learn and continue their music development in the fundamentals of music and instrument play.

6th Grade Wheel Course descriptions:

Students will rotate between **Health**, Study Hall, **Computer Coding**, Study Hall, **Eco-Literacy** and again Study Hall.

Health: Students will explore what it means to be healthy. They will understand components of physical, mental, emotional, and social health.

Computer Coding: Students will learn the foundations to coding and electronics in multiple applications. Using critical thinking skills and creative production, they will design and code various programs based on an assigned purpose and build input-output circuits using Arduino micro-controller boards.

Eco-literacy: This course is designed to reconnect students with the natural world and introduce them to ecological principals, while cultivating a mindfulness of their place in the interconnected web of life. Through creative thinking, sustainable practices and hand-on activities, students will be actively involved in manifesting change in their daily lives and local community.

Study Hall: This course is designed for students to get a head start on completing homework during the school day. Students work in a quiet environment with a credentialed teacher who is available to answer questions.
