8th Grade Dance Update

Angie Sullivan updating that we're securing the Rancho Canada for the 8th Grade School Dance this year. Past dances have been at CYC but they aren't renting their space out on Friday evenings any longer.

Need to pay for DJ and Photobooth (under \$1,000) Close to \$5500 total for rental and food. Asking for an increase to budget for \$5,000. (Currently at \$3,000). Talked about using funds allocated for 6th and 7th grade parties as well as for the end of Trimester allocated funds (which we didn't use). Dan would like to scale back on younger grades and put the resources toward 8th graders (a celebration of ending Middle School).

Discussed charging \$10 per student. Preselling tickets.

How far in advance should we do ticket sales? Dan is suggesting right after Spring Break.

Angie asked if we're having Chili dinner for Open House Night? There've been limitations put on the school because of the food law requirements. Dan will ask Ben Eichorn if he'd be interested in showcasing the Habitat during Open House night (potentially providing appetizers to families) This would replace the chili dinner.
