Principal's Report- New Project, Ways and Means:

- Dan Morgan met with Dan Paul regarding wiffle ball field. The old concrete will be taken out, the area will be leveled and new sod will be put in. The tree in the outfield will be cut down. There will be new concrete, bases and stands repainted. Cost will be around \$8,000-\$10,000. The project will be done in the summer. CUSD employees will do the bulk of work.

- Add 3 concrete Cornhole stations in the upper lawn area.
