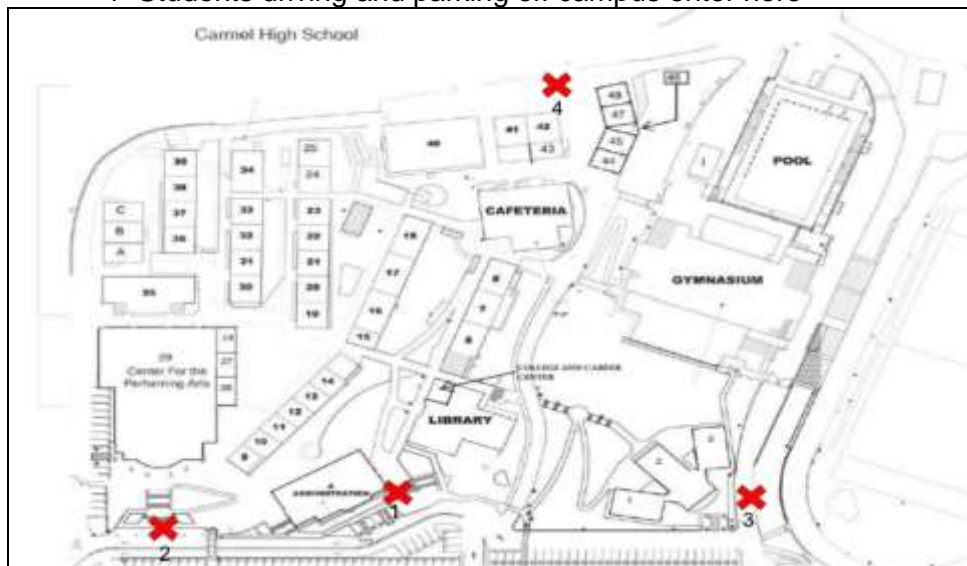

HEALTH AND SAFETY

- Students will not be punished for high-fiving or fist-bumping or hugging their friends. However, this is discouraged and students may be reminded by staff to refrain if excessive.

STUDENT check in:

- Check in can occur at any of the marked drop off points. Please use the following guidelines for entering campus;
 - 1- Students being dropped off by a parent enter here
 - 2- Students walking to school enter here
 - 3- Students driving themselves enter here
 - 4- Students driving and parking off campus enter here



- Students may not leave campus during lunch
- The Parking Lot is off limits during the day, grab what you need for the whole day!
- Parking Permits will be available during the first week of school
- Lunch service is grab and go from 1) The outdoor cafeteria windows 2) Snack Bar near Football Field or 3) Snack Shed outside Rooms 16/17. Lunch is free for all students. Please complete a [brief survey](#) indicating if you will participate in the free breakfast and lunch program. This will help us determine the number of breakfasts and lunches to make so as to minimize waste.
- Students with an open period 1, 3, 4, or 7 may arrive late or leave campus. Students with an open period 2,5,6 can take advantage of a “Free” Period;
 - Students may use the free period to study, get appointment help from a teacher, visit Counseling or College/Career Center or decompress and recharge in preparation for the remainder of the day
 - Students may go to the Library, Foyer of Cafeteria, or the Amphitheater
 - Students may not be in the following areas -- Outside classrooms where class is in session or hanging out in the bathrooms
- Distance Learning students can come onto campus for after school sports or office hours only.
- Students may use their breaks to hang out with friends, visit the library or check in with teachers.
