College Prep Classes:

Standard high school curriculum based on state standards and approved by 4-year colleges

Estimated Daily Homework: 15-30 min *(varies by class)*

Honors Classes:

Similar content to college preparatory classes, but covered in greater depth.

Estimated Daily Homework: 30 min *(varies by class)*

Advanced Placement Classes:

College-level curriculum & textbook that covers a breadth of information and material.

Estimated Daily Homework: 45-90 min *(varies by class)*
