Requirements for Senior Quotes

- No profanity or drug will be tolerated. (The yearbook staff retains the right to edit/take out anything that is inappropriate).
- Do not write anything that you won't want to read about in 20 years (i.e. romantic notes, inside jokes you will forget, etc.)
- We will correct obvious typos and errors.
- 100 words MAXIMUM

Requirements for Senior Portraits

The requirements for senior photos this year are like previous years, but the specifications are important to keep in mind when choosing your shot. This year, we ask you to submit TWO senior portraits - one horizontal and one vertical (preferably with dimensions of 2x2.5 or 2.5x2). Make sure you like both pictures equally because **ONLY ONE** will be put in the yearbook. Listed below are the requirements and specifications needed. Thank you.

- TWO senior portraits, one formatted horizontally, the other vertically. (Not a school ID or candid shot.)
- ONE baby photo (Non-school ID photos are encouraged.)
- Portraits NEED to be 300 DPI (If not, pictures will be blurry) and RGB or CMYK format; they should be jpegs or TIFFs.
- Please refrain from submitting photos that have been edited in Instagram; the filters and low resolution make the photos appear blurry.n

IMPORTANT: All materials (quotations, portraits, and childhood pictures) should be submitted as attachments by e-mail to carmelhighseniors@gmail.com before the deadline.

Please take into consideration that you will have this yearbook for the rest of your life, so choose your photos carefully and get them in on time. To ensure that your photos and quotes will appear in the yearbook, MAKE SURE TO HAVE YOUR STUFF IN BY NOVEMBER 3rd! If you are late, we will still try to get you in the yearbook, but we might have to use your I.D. photo.
