SPOTLIGHTING INFORMATION FROM AND ACTIONS OF THE CARMEL UNIFIED BOARD OF EDUCATION

Meeting of February 15, 2023

Action/Discussion/Information Items

- The Board approved the J-13A "Request for Allowance of Attendance" as presented: Beginning on December 27, 2022, severe winter storms related to a series of atmospheric river systems struck California, bringing high winds, falling debris, downed trees, and widespread power outages. Local mandatory evacuations and road closures on January 9, 10 and 11, 2023, resulted in district wide closures. The Board approved a J-13A "Request for Allowance of Attendance Because of Emergency Conditions" due to school site closures, on January 10 and 11.
- The Board approved Resolution #23-01 Authorization to Establish a Trust Account in the Carmel High School ASB for the Purpose of Fundraising on the Behalf of Monterey County's "Kids Now" and "Kids Need" Programs: Carmel High School ASB Club and the CHS Art Club requested authorization to conduct a fundraising event to benefit the Food Bank for Monterey County's "Kids Now" and "Kids Need" programs. This resolution provides the clubs the authorization to host the fundraising event.
- The Board approved 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 School Academic Calendars: Craig Chavez, Chief Human Resources Officer, reviewed the comprehensive development of school year calendars for the following two years by the School Calendar Advisory Committee.
