- We will correct obvious typos and errors.
- 100 words MAXIMUM

**Requirements for Senior Portraits**

This year the formatting for the senior section has a unique design, which will be both more interesting and more visually pleasing than other past formats. However, to achieve this special format, we need your help! This year, we ask you to submit TWO senior portraits - one horizontal and one vertical (preferably with dimensions of 3x2 or 2x3). Make sure you like both pictures equally because **ONLY ONE will be put in the yearbook**. Thank you for helping this yearbook, especially the Senior section, be the best it can be!

- TWO senior photos (see above).
- One baby picture or child photo. (Make it cute!)
- One candid highlighting a favorite memory of high school. e
- Portraits NEED to be 300 DPI and CMYK format; jpeg or TIFF (If not, pictures will be blurry).
- Please refrain from submitting photos that have been edited in Instagram; the filters and low resolution make the photos appear blurry.

**IMPORTANT:** All materials (quotations, portraits, and baby pictures) should be submitted by e-mail to [carmelhighseniors@gmail.com](mailto:carmelhighseniors@gmail.com) as attachments before the deadline.

Please take into consideration that you will have this yearbook for the rest of your life, so choose your photos carefully and get them in on time. To ensure that your photos and quotes will appear in the yearbook, **MAKE SURE TO HAVE YOUR STUFF IN BY NOVEMBER 1ST! If you are late, we will still try to get you in the yearbook, but we might have to use your I.D. photo.**
