Monday - Welcome to Checkmate with Brendyn Estolas*

Instructor Brendyn Estolas is the grandson of Ted Yudacufski (Mr. Yu), who started the chess program at River School, and has been playing chess since the age of 4. He has played in over 200 tournaments throughout his lifetime. Brendyn has the skills and strategies that would be perfect for your child to learn the game of chess. Brendyn is an exciting coach who knows how to interact with the students very well. Chess is a wonderful game that exercises the mind in many ways. The classic game of chess develops spatial thinking and uses both sides of the brain. This class is geared for all levels. Whether you are a beginner or an expert, you can still learn many new strategies. During this class, students will learn the basic rules and principles, opening tactics, how to checkmate with king and queen, rook and queen, and many other chess techniques. Chess improves concentration, problem solving skills, memory, creativity, and much more. Chess has been a male dominant game for many years but girls are just as capable of learning the game as well! It would be awesome to see more of a female presence in the chess world! There will be a materials fee of \$15 to pay for workbooks and a party at the end of this session. ***Materials fee of \$15 payable to instructor due on the first day of class. Monday – LEGO® Club -With Mrs. Nicole Tiffany*

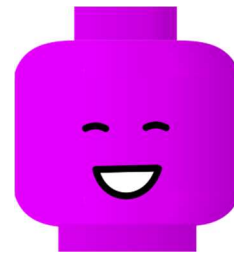
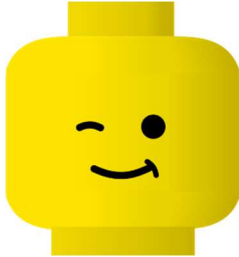
