As stated in California Education Code Section 35330, "All persons making the field trip or excursion are deemed to have waived all claims against the District of the State of California for any injury, accident, illness or death occurring during or by reason of the field trip or excursion."

I fully understand that participants are to abide by all rules and regulations governing conduct during the trip. During such field trips or excursions, students are still subject to school rules and regulations. I also understand that the belongings and luggage of secondary students may be subject to inspection by non-aggressive dogs specially trained to detect illegal substances. Any violation of these rules and regulations may result in that individual being sent home at his/her and/or parents' expense and appropriate disciplinary action.
