Carmel River Elementary Programs Highlighted

River School principal Jay Marden and his staff made a presentation to the Board highlighting instructional goals, social emotional wellness, and professional development for teachers.

Facilities Master Plan Process Underway

The Board received an update from LPA Architectural Firm on the Facilities Master Plan process currently underway. A timeline was shared highlighting next steps, including stakeholder input and review of conceptual drawings.

Enrollment Projections

Enrollment projections for the 2019-20 school year were presented to establish budgetary assumptions for the coming fiscal year.

Water Agreement Clears Way for New Restrooms at River

The Board approved the Monterey Peninsula Water Management District agreement to amend the deed restriction at River School to allow for installation of new restroom facilities.

Preschool Funding Resolution Approved

The Board approved a resolution regarding the state's reimbursement funding formula for our preschool students.

The Board approved three new courses for Carmel High School: Auto Service II; Video Productions III; and AP Studio Art - 3D Design. Dr. DePrez reviewed the district process used by staff.

Annual Organizational Meeting Set for December 12

The Board approved December 12, 2018, for its annual organizational meeting, at which they will elect officers, authorize signatures, approve their meeting schedule, and appoint Board representatives to various organizations and committees. The meeting will start at 5:30 p.m. in Room P1 of Carmel Middle School.

The Board approved the Board Policies and Bylaw updates. Staff will take the approved policies back to the Board Policy Committee, with the option for the committee to bring recommended changes back at a future Board meeting for review and approval.
