Environmental Responsibility Team

Carmel Middle School Teacher Darrell Steely, co-chair of the Environmental Responsibility Team, made a presentation to the Board on the many ecoliteracy activities and curricular initiatives present at all sites.

Community Human Services Contribution Approved Community Human Services informed the Board about the services it provides to our residents in this, its 50th year. The Board approved the annual contribution of \$7500 as its portion of the Joint Powers Allocation.

Approve Appointment of Carmel High School Principal The Board approved the employment agreement and appointment of Jonathan Lyons as the new Carmel High School principal. He begins on July 1, 2019.

Approve Appointment of Director of Fiscal Services The Board approved the employment agreement and appointment of the Director of Fiscal Services, Tu My Vuong.

Hearing for 2019-20 College and Career Access Pathway Agreement between CHS and MPC Dr. Suzie DePrez was joined by representatives from Monterey Peninsula College to preside over a required hearing for the (CCAP) 2019-20 College and Career Access Pathway Agreement. This agreement will support several new dual enrollment courses at Carmel High school: Sports Medicine, U.S. History, and Career Guidance.

Transportation Dept. Re-Org. and New/Updated Job Descriptions

The Board approved a re-organization of the Transportation Department and new/updated job descriptions as presented by MOT Director Mr. Dan Paul.

Chief Business Official Compensation for up to 10 Additional Work Days The Board approved up to 10 additional work days for Mr. Rick Blanckmeister to ease the transition for the new CBO.

Independent Contractor Services Agreement: Extended Term Services - Jeanette Ayala The Board approved up to four days of additional work for Jeanette Ayala to provide assistance for her replacement, the new Director of Fiscal Services.

California School Boards Association 2019 Delegate Assembly Election Candidate John Hill was approved by the Board as their choice to represent the district at the CSBA 2019 Delegate Assembly.
