Better utilize the CUSD SRO	The Sheriff Resource Officer will assist on the delivery of the curriculum focusing on the issues here in Monterey County and the greater Carmel area. The SRO will also include the legal issues that a minor can experience with alcohol and drug use. Also to include the medical implications of drug and alcohol abuse.
